Dominic McHenry is a British artist who's main medium is sculpture. He is one third of Bask collective Who working on numerous public commissions and exhibitions.

Dominic's solo work takes form from geometry and repeating patterns. This gives them a tangible logic as if they hold a functional purpose. He often works in series, each time following a pre determined set of rules; only cutting into one face of the material at alternating measurements, or working within a grid system to produce the maximum number of combinations. This mathematical approach has a chain reaction like a carefully placed row of domino.
